SPECIAL DAYS AND EVENTS IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-24

➤ WORLD EARTH DAY:-

The children learnt about the five Rs – reuse, recycle, repurpose, reduce and refuse through a storytelling session conducted by Dipna Daryanani, founder of a sustainable clothing brand in Mumbai, India.

➤ PULSES DAY:-

Students learnt about the health benefits of pulses, brought a pulse-based lunch and also listened to a story about how pulses taste best when enjoyed together, narrated by Binita Sashi, educator and storyteller in Chennai, India.

➤ STORY TELLING DAY:-

Students narrated stories to their friends in class and also listened to a story, narrated by Anagha Bharat, special educator in Mumbai, India.

➤ ART FROM WASTE DAY:-

Students were asked to bring waste material from home – newspapers, bottles, jars – and used them to make items like dolls and flower vases.

➤ OBON ODORI CELEBRATION:-

Students and teachers wore the traditional dress and celebrated by dancing to three different dances. They also wrote their wishes and hung it on the bamboo tree.

➤ SPORTS DAY:-

Students put up a spectacular performance during their first annual Sports Day. They participated in drills, poses and formations and also took part in several races.

➤ CLAY MODELLING DAY:-

Students made items that they liked using clay, such as cartoon characters, flowers, pots and jewellery.

➤ WINTER CONCERT:-

Our second winter concert was a medley of dance, music and drama. Our Sakura class participated in a fancy dress show and graders took part in a Christmas-themed skit, an environmental play, regional and western dances.

➤ FIRELESS COOKING DAY:-

Students were given time to think about what they would like to prepare in class and brought the ingredients from home, accordingly. They assembled their dishes in class and these were judged by an external facilitator, based on creativity, taste and presentation.

➤ POETRY RECITATION DAY:-

Students were encouraged to recite their favorite poem in class. Teachers also chose a theme and recited poems to students.

➤ FIELD TRIPS AND EXCURSIONS:-

Students are taken for a field visit/ farm visit, where they engage in vegetable picking and get to know how they are grown and cultivated. They are also taken for an excursion once in every academic year. Such events will be conducted on a regular basis and our aim is to have at least one special day a month. We will add new days and events as we step into new academic years.
