6. Dark blue socks



SPECIAL DAYS AND EVENTS

➤ WORLD EARTH DAY:-

The children learn about the five Rs – reuse, recycle, repurpose, reduce and refuse plastics. They also learn the importance of growing plants and trees.

➤ PULSES DAY:-

Students learn about the health benefits of pulses; they bring a pulse-based lunch and also listen to stories about how pulses taste best when enjoyed together.

➤ STORY TELLING DAY:-

Students narrate stories to their friends in class and also listen to stories based on different topics. This helps them to speak more confidently in a crowd of audience.

➤ ART FROM WASTE DAY:-

Students are asked to bring waste material from home – newspapers, bottles, jars – and use them to make items like dolls and flower vases.

➤ OBON ODORI CELEBRATION:-

Students and teachers wear the traditional dress and celebrate by dancing to three different dances. They also write their wishes and hang it on a bamboo tree.

➤ SPORTS DAY:-

Students put up a spectacular performance during their annual Sports Day. They participate in drills, poses and formations and also take part in several races.

➤ CLAY MODELLING DAY:-

Students make items that they liked using clay, such as cartoon characters, flowers, pots and jewelry.

➤ WINTER CONCERT:-

Our winter concert is a medley of dance, music and drama. Our Sakura class participated in a fancy dress show and graders took part in skit, an environmental play, regional and western dances.

➤ FIRELESS COOKING DAY:-

Students are given time to think about what they would like to prepare in class and they bring the ingredients from home, accordingly. They assemble their dishes in class and these were judged by an external facilitator, based on creativity, taste and presentation.

➤ POETRY RECITATION DAY:-

Students are encouraged to recite their favorite poem in class. Teachers also choose a theme and recite poems to students.

➤ **FIELD TRIPS AND EXCURSIONS:-**

Students are taken for a field visit/ farm visit, where they engage in vegetable picking and get to know how they are grown and cultivated. They are also taken for an excursion once in every academic year. Such events will be conducted on a regular basis and our aim is to have at least one special day a month. We will add new days and events as we step into new academic years.
